### Full Time Speech-Language Pathologist

The successful candidate will work on a multidisciplinary team and will be responsible for the planning and implementation of speech and language programming that meets the unique needs of the child with whom they work.

#### RESPONSIBILITIES

- Development and coaching of Speech and Language therapy programming in a classroom setting

- Conduct screenings and assessments of preschool and school-aged children using formal and informal measures

- Monitor and update program plans and participate in meetings with the multidisciplinary team and families
- Collaborate with families, multidisciplinary team members, teachers, and Child Development Assistants (CDA) to target goals in a variety of settings
- Participate and assist with scheduling of Family Oriented Programming Sessions (FOPS) within the ECS program
- Provide yearly assessment and treatment summary reports and maintain documentation standards of professional college
