The position is a full-time and requires availability on weekdays and weeknight evenings until 6:00pm.

They will be responsible for the planning and implementation of Speech-Language programming that meets the unique needs of the children and families with whom they work.

- Developing functional, multidisciplinary Service Provider Program Plan (SPPP) goals and Individual Service Plans (ISP) that promote parent education and empowerment
- Monitoring and updating program plans and participating in meetings with the interdisciplinary team and families
- Collaborating with families, interdisciplinary team members, and Child Development Assistants to target goals in a variety of settings
- Providing education and training to Pacekids' staff and Child Development Assistants
