The successful candidate will work on contracts funded through Children's Services; they will be responsible for the planning and implementation of physiotherapy programming and/or assessments that meets the unique needs of the children and families with whom they work.

- Delivering formal assessments; executing assessments and providing appropriate reporting as outlined by Children's Services
- Coaching and consulting with families in the home setting and providing appropriate strategies and recommendations for a child's programming
- Utilizing a Trauma Informed approach
- Ensuring delivery of services is in alignment with Pacekids' policy and procedures as well as with the Child Intervention Practice Framework
- Collaborating with Children's Services, families, interdisciplinary team members and other members of the family's support network to target goals, in a variety of settings
