Pacekids Programs is looking for a contract Pediatric (Provisional or Registered) Psychologist based out of the North Pacekids Location (808 55th Ave NE), working within families' homes in the Calgary area. The position requires availability during week days, and weeknight evenings until 6:00pm. Total hours per month would be negotiated with the successful candidate. The position would commence as soon as possible.

Pacekids Programs offers a variety of programs to children in the Calgary area, including our Early Childhood Services (ECS) Preschool and Kindergarten programs funded by Alberta Learning, and our Specialized Services program funded through Family Supports for Children with Disabilities (FSCD). We are currently seeking an energetic and dynamic individual to join our team as a Pediatric (Provisional or Registered) Psychologist who would be involved in the home-based FSCD programs.

The successful candidate will work on an interdisciplinary team and will be responsible for the planning and implementation of behaviour related programming that meets the unique needs of the children and families with whom they work.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Coaching and consulting with families' in the home setting and providing appropriate strategies and recommendations for a child's programming
- Conducting screenings and assessments of preschool and school-aged children using formal and informal assessments
- Developing functional, multidisciplinary service plan goals that promote parent education and empowerment
- Monitoring and updating program plans and participating in meetings with the interdisciplinary team and families
- Collaborating with families, interdisciplinary team members, teachers and Child Development Assistants to target goals in a variety of settings
- Train team members on data gathering and implementation of the intervention programs using hands-on, role-play, etc.
- Attend staff meetings and other trainings
- Work collaboratively and communicate clearly with families, other therapists and other members of the Pacekids team
- Providing regular assessment and treatment update reports
- Providing education and training to Pacekids' staff and Child Development Assistants
